Shree Buddha Secondary School foundation school in Godawari 06, Lalitpur has been an environment where students from various ethnic groups and backgrounds come together to build the future of Nepal. Shree Buddha Secondary School aims to provide quality access to



education. In its recent years, the school has been receiving a tremendous number of students since it is one of two governmental foundation schools in town. The school has four rooms in one construction and six rooms in one foundation. According to the school teacher, the classrooms are no longer a stimulating

educational environment because there are approximately 392 students who are all hungry-to-learn and that number exceeds the classroom's capacity. Therefore, the reached out to VolNepal to work on a better educational environment for the students. In VolNepal, we got the call from the school in August of 2019, We touched the need for a better, sustainable educational environment and we started to communicate by building classrooms.

Then it was through the continuous support of Mr. Alexander Moghadam that enabled VolNepal to initiate the project of Shree Buddha school construction

## INTRODUCTION OF SCHOOL



Shree Buddha Secondary School is a government school located at Godawari (Ward no. 9), Lalitpur. The school was first operated in different locations with limited number of students and later around 2028 B.S it got permanently established in Godawari, Tikabhairav area. At present, there are 452 students studying in Buddha School. The students in Buddha school are not only from Lalitpur but also from

outside the valley. The school provides classes from nursery to 10. Students in Buddha school are given a lot of opportunity to explore their interests as they are encouraged to participate in various extracurricular activities like various competitions, contests, programs which are held every Friday after half day classes.

Shree Buddha Secondary school has been providing a great educational platform for students who have a lot of potential and desire to learn but have been financially struggling. With the change in time and technology Buddha School has brought

necessary changes in its infrastructure. In order to expand the facilities Buddha School had reached out to VolNepal on 2019 A.D for support. Considering the requirements and with the aim of facilitating the students we began our construction project in Buddha School.

The VolNepal construction project of 2019 & 2020 was to build 6 rooms in Buddha School. With the help of volunteers and workers we were able to complete the project.
